

1. Our Project Team

This team will **drive projects in our respective sectors**. They are **not required to join the in person trip**, and can instead create & manage projects



2. In person team

This team will plan and deliver project work **on the ground during a two week trip in June/July**



The Application process:



1. Fill out the application form

2. Have a 30 min call with the team

3. If successful join the team,

4. Join Planning stage

5. Aram Team will choose team for group 1 and 2

KEY FACTS ABOUT THE TRIP

When will the trip be taking place?

The trip will be taking place **mid to late June 2026**. It will last for **two weeks**, and we will confirm the dates (based on volunteers' availabilities) once finalised.

Will there be experienced chaperones on the trip?

Yes, we will be **chaperoned by experienced individuals** from our partner charities and our organisers!

How much does the trip cost? (Excluding flight cost)

Trip cost will be **~£500** (exact amount will be confirmed after trip details are finalised). You will be **responsible for booking your own flights alongside the group**.

What is included in the trip cost?

The trip cost will cover all expenses related to **travel whilst in Sri Lanka, accommodation, and three meals per day** for the entire duration of the trip. No admin costs are added
